

The Narth and District Village Hall 100 Club Rules



1. The 100 Club will be operated under The Gambling Act 2005, which deals with a Small Society Lottery. The promoter will be the Chair, The Narth and District Village Hall Management Committee.
2. The Village Hall Management Committee reserves the right to alter the Rules of the 100 Club from time to time, as may be necessary. A copy of the current Rules will be available on our website: www.thenarthhall.org.uk
3. The object of the Club is to raise funds for The Narth and District Village Hall.
4. The 100 Club will be run under the supervision of The Narth and District Village Hall Committee who will also administer the 100 Club. The draw will normally take place at the monthly Village Hall Committee meetings in the presence of at least 3 committee members, at least one of whom will be the Chair, the Treasurer or the Secretary.
5. The Club is open to all Residents of The Narth, Maryland and Pen Y Fan and the surrounding area, their family and friends.
6. Members must be 16 or over.
7. Membership will be by subscription of £1 per month per number, paid annually in advance (£12 per number per year) in September. Members may have more than one number, on payment of additional subscriptions.
8. The regular monthly prize fund will be 75% of the monthly income— there will be two prizes:-
 - 1st prize = 2/3 of monthly prize fund
 - 2nd prize = 1/3 of monthly prize fund
9. Registers will be kept recording the name and address of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them. Members should advise the Village Hall Committee if their contact details change.
10. Winners will be contacted personally and names will be posted in the newsletter, on the notice board and on the website each month after the draw. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into The Narth and District Village Hall Funds after 6 months.
11. Participants can cancel their membership at any time by giving one month's written notice to the Treasurer. Any decision by The Narth and District Village Hall Committee to wind up the 100 Club will also be by one month's written notice. Under no circumstances can any payments be refunded.
